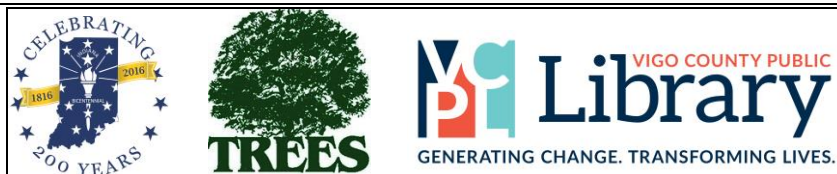

Entries Accepted: Monday, November 7 – Wednesday, November 9, 2016 by 5:00 p.m.

Subject: Photo entries must include a tree(s), or part of a tree(s).

Limit: Up to 3 photos may be submitted per entrant.

Media: Color or Black and White

Size: 8 x 10 inches or larger

Presentation: Photos must be mounted. They cannot be matted or framed. Photography or frame shops can also provide help.

Submission: Please submit each photo individually in its own protective envelope with a completed entry form for that photo. The photographer's name, address and phone number must be written on the back of the photo and on the outside of the protective envelope.

Awards: \$100.00 each will be presented for first place, \$75.00 for second place and \$50.00 for third place in each of the three contest divisions:
